How do we describe rivers?

Rivers:

DEFINITION 2

- Form on high ground like mountains or hills. They flow downhill across the land into a sea, a lake or another river.

They have:

- Fresh water.
- A **source** where the river begins.
- A **mouth** where the river ends.
- A **course**, which is the journey of the river from the source to the mouth.
- **Tributaries**, which are smaller rivers that join to the main river.

What are the different parts of the course of a river?

We divide rivers into three parts:

- The **upper course**. This is near the source. The water moves fast and carries sand and pebbles with it.
- The **middle course**. The river flows over flat land and has meanders.
- The **lower course**. This is near the mouth. The water moves slowly and deposits the sand and pebbles*.

What are the characteristics of a river?

The characteristics of a river depend on the climate and the relief of the landscape. We measure three main characteristics:

- The **length** of the river is the distance from the source to the mouth.
- The **discharge** is the amount of water the river carries through a fixed point at a fixed time.
- A **stable regime** means the amount of water the river carries doesn't change very much. A **variable regime** means the amount of water changes over the year.

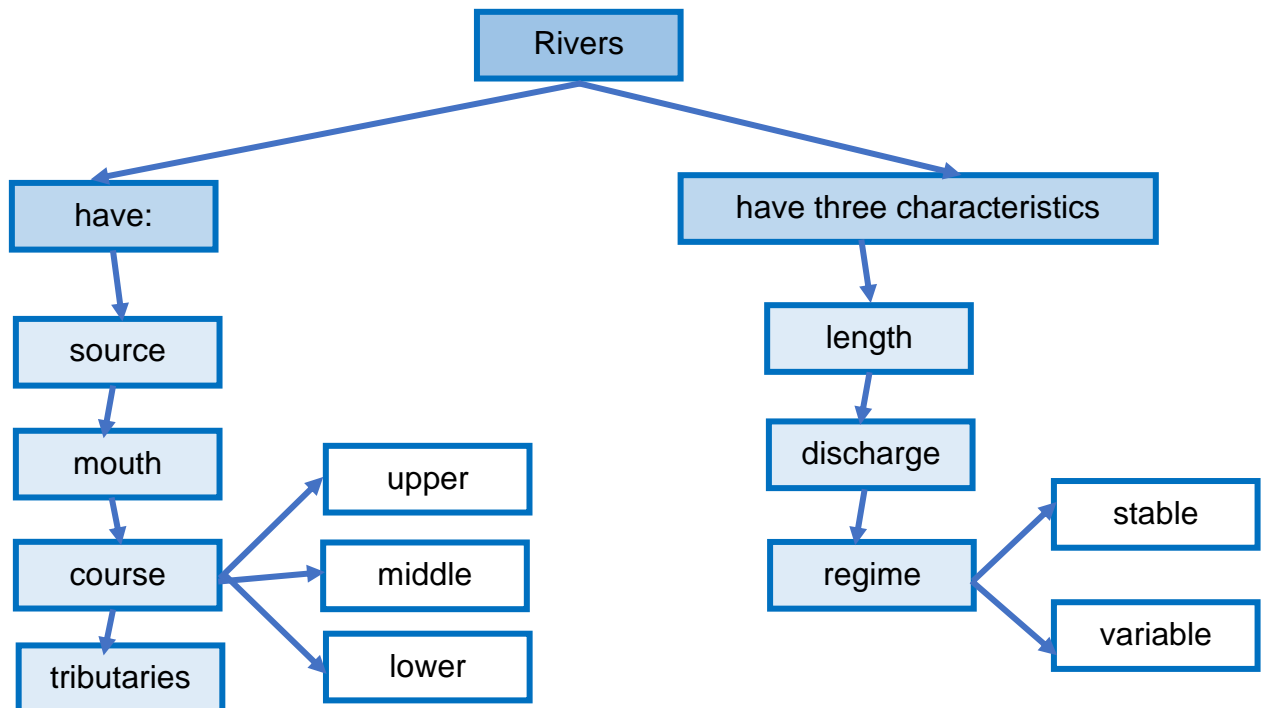
