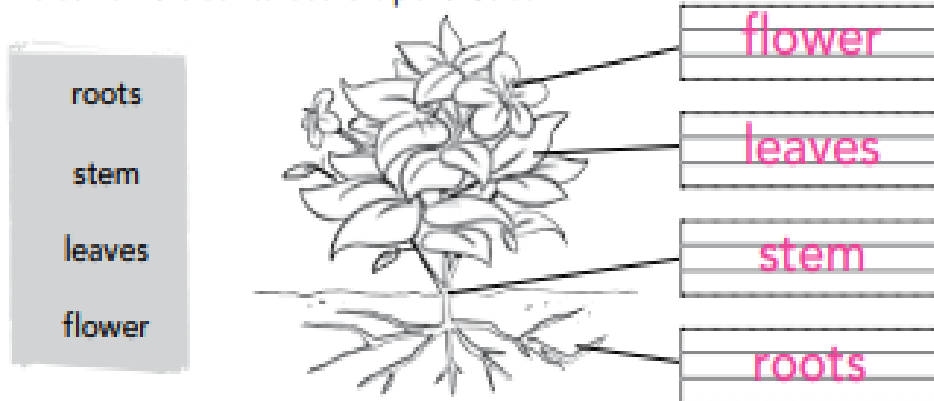

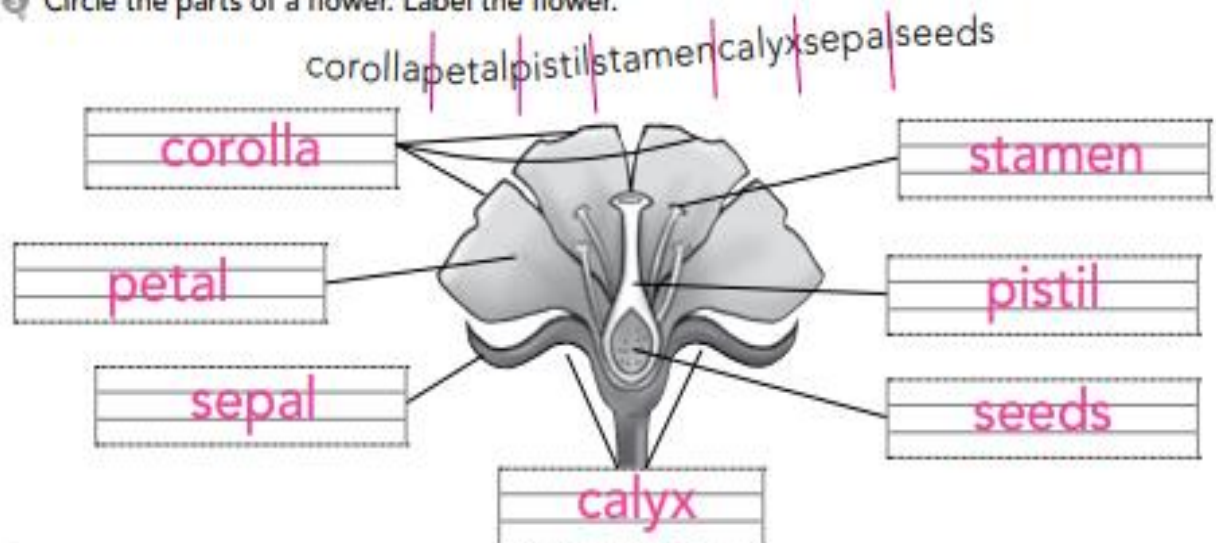

March

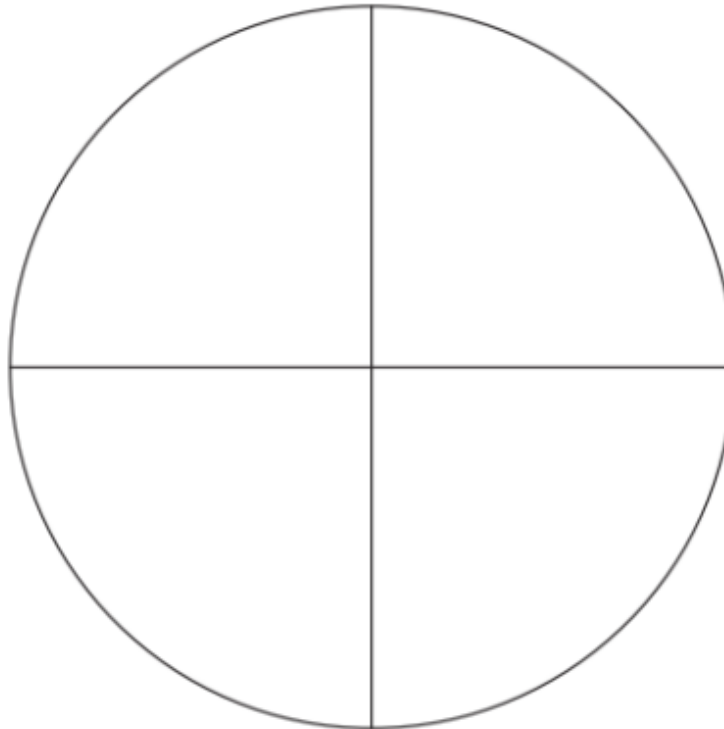


Autumn months are:

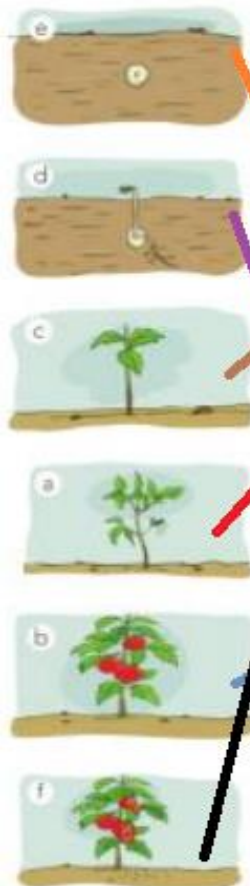
