Grammar – Comparatives and Superlatives

Comparatives: adjective + -er + than / more + adjective + than

Example: Anna is funnier than Tom.

Superlatives: the + adjective + -est / the most + adjective

Example: Lily is the kindest girl in class.

Short adjectives → add “-er / -est” (tall → taller / the tallest)

Long adjectives → use “more / the most” (friendly → more friendly / the most friendly)
