- 1) Look at those clouds! It's **going to rain** soon. (Prediction based on present evidence — we can see the clouds.)
- 2) Don't worry, I **will help** you with your homework. (Offer made at the moment of speaking — instant decision.)
- 3) The film **starts** at 8:30 tonight. (Timetabled event — present simple for schedules.)
- 4) We don't have any milk. I'll buy some later. (Instant decision made while speaking.)
- 5) Watch out! You're **going to drop** your phone! (Prediction based on present evidence — the phone is slipping.)
- 6) I think our team **will win** the championship this year. (Prediction based on opinion or belief.)
- 7) The train **leaves** at 7:45 tomorrow morning. (Timetabled event — present simple.)
- 8) It's 8:55! Hurry up, the lesson **starts** in five minutes! (Scheduled event — present simple.)
- 9) I've decided that I'm **going to** start going to the gym next week. (Plan or intention decided before speaking.)
- 10) Be careful! You're **going to** spill your coffee! (Prediction based on present evidence — the cup is tilting.)
- 11) "We're out of sugar." — "Okay, I'll **go** to the shop." (Instant decision — made at the moment of speaking.)
- 12) The shop **opens** at 10 o'clock on Sundays. (Timetable or schedule — present simple.)
- 13) She's very talented. I'm sure she'll **be** a great actress. (Prediction based on belief or opinion.)
- 14) Look at that boy on the ladder! He's **going to** fall! (Prediction based on present evidence — he's losing balance.)
- 15) I'm **going to visit** my grandparents this weekend; I already told them. (Plan or intention decided before speaking.)
