## What's the difference between vertebrates and invertebrates?

- 1 Read about vertebrates and invertebrates. Then match the questions with the answers.

**Vertebrates** are animals with a **skeleton** of **bones** inside their bodies. Their skeleton has a **spine** or a backbone. A spine helps vertebrates to move. Vertebrates can fly, swim or run. They can live on land, like a wolf, or in water, like a seahorse. Birds and fish, reptiles and mammals are all vertebrates. The blue whale is the biggest vertebrate. It's about 30 metres long.

**Invertebrates** haven't got a skeleton or a spine. They can have soft bodies, like jellyfish and rays, or hard shells, like oysters and crabs. Invertebrates can also live on land, like spiders, or in water, like lobsters. Different vertebrates can fly, swim, run and float. Most invertebrates are small, but the giant squid is the biggest invertebrate. It's about 20 metres long.
